SKeyes website attacked by hackers

(SKEYES/IFEX) - 12 February 2011 - SKeyes.org, the official website for SKeyes Center for Media and Cultural Freedom, was subjected to an act of piracy by a "Saudi" hacker calling himself Khaled al-Anzi.

The attacker posted a message on the site, dedicating the act of piracy to the King of Saudi Arabia, Abdul-lah Bin Abdel-Aziz, and to Syrian President Bashar Assad.

The "Saudi" hacker also wrote on the page "anyone who dares to mention the soldier will be removed".

SKeyes Center for Media and Cultural Freedom strongly condemns the cowardly attack on freedom of speech, and calls on the authorities to identify and punish the attacker.
